to some truly surreal and sinister variations on the theme. Lomax (work pictured) goes for the jugular with her 11 paintings about the blonde bombshell Jayne Mansfield, which include the car crash that killed her, while Sarah Doyle nurtures the narcissism in her paintings of actresses playing other actresses. **JL**
